

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

### St Paul's P&F Association TUITION FEE RAFFLE 2019

#### **Lottery permit**

The St Paul's P&F Association Tuition Raffle 2019 (Raffle) is being conducted pursuant to lottery permit LS212706619 [issued by the Department of Racing, Gaming and Liquor] The Permit is held by Jacqueline Quinn, President, St Paul's P&F Association of 7 Learoyd St, Mt Lawley WA 6050 (St Paul's PS) to conduct and promote the Lottery in Western Australia.

#### **Lottery Permit Holder:**

Jacqueline Quinn, President, St Paul's P&F Association.

- The Raffle is a fundraising initiative and all proceeds raised will be used to improve the outdoor play spaces throughout the school grounds.

#### **Promotion Period**

- **Raffle begins:** Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> February 2019 12:00PM AWST.
- **Final ticket sales close:** Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2019 11:59PM AWST (unless sold out prior to this time)
- **Draw date:** Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> April 2019 at St Paul's PS at 2.00PM AWST.

#### **Terms and Conditions**

- Purchasers must be 18 years or older.
  - Only 250 tickets at \$50 each will be sold.
  - There is no limit on the number of tickets that can be purchased by each individual Purchaser (subject to the overall ticket limit of 250).
  - No person is permitted to participate in the lottery until the whole purchase price of the ticket has been paid.
  - Proceeds from the sale of the Raffle tickets will go towards the improvement of the outdoor play spaces throughout the school grounds
  - The winner will be notified in writing and the name of the winner will be published in the St Paul's PS newsletter, on Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> April.
  - St Paul's PS may use a prize winner's details for promotional purposes. By purchasing a Raffle ticket, the Purchaser agrees that if the Purchaser is a prize winner, the Purchaser will participate in reasonable media activities concerning the Raffle draw and will consent to photographs or video of the winner being used for St Paul's PS marketing and promotional activities (both in print and on the internet).
  - The Raffle draw is subject to a minimum number of tickets being sold, as determined by St Paul's PS, namely 150 tickets. If the required minimum number of tickets are not sold by the closing date, the Raffle will be cancelled and all monies refunded in full to the Purchaser, subject to the approval of and any conditions imposed by the Department of Racing, Gaming and Liquor WA.
- Main Draw** • Assuming all tickets are sold, each ticket has a 1 in 250 chance of winning the prize.
- The prize value is \$5000 in Tuition Fees only.

- The sum of \$5000 (Tuition Fees) will be credited to the 2019 account of the winner's oldest student attending Paul's in 2019. If the winning ticket holder is a grandparent, aunt or uncle of an enrolled student the prize can be credited to the account of the enrolled student. Unused portions can be carried over to the student's 2020 account or to siblings of the student provided the student is attending St Paul's in 2019 or 2020.
- If the winner has already made full or part payment of 2019 tuition fees the Bursar will refund the amount paid and apply the credit to the account.
- The prize must be redeemed within 12 months of the draw date (by March 23<sup>rd</sup> 2020) by notifying The Bursar, St Paul's PS of the winner's intention to redeem the prize.
- Unused balances cannot be redeemed for cash and are not refundable in any portion, but may be donated as a Bursary to St Paul's PS, to be anonymously distributed to families in financial hardship, as determined by the Principal and Bursar.
- If the winner so chooses, the prize may be donated to St Paul's PS as a Bursary, to be anonymously distributed to a family or families in financial hardship, as determined by the Principal and Bursar.
- Prize is not transferable or redeemable in cash.
- Tickets are not transferrable.
- In the event enrolment ceases prior to the full value been applied, strictly no refunds will apply.
- The prize will be applied to tuition fees only of the nominated student. Costs incurred by optional co curricular activities and levies are not included in the annual tuition fee.

**Conduct of Draw** The prize draw will be conducted by the St Paul's Principal at St Paul's PS, 7 Learoyd St, Mount Lawley WA 6050 computer generated selection. The winner will be notified by telephone or email and their name will be published in St Paul's Newsletter that week. The decision of the Principal (or delegate) will be final and binding.

Unclaimed prizes will be dealt with in accordance with the procedures set out in the Gaming and Wagering Commission Act 1987 (WA).

**Refunds:** Refunds can only be processed prior to the date of the prize draw. Requests for refunds will need written approval of the Department of Racing, Gaming and Liquor WA. This process may take a number of weeks. Refunds cannot be issued after the prize draws.

**Changes:** Where it is lawful to do so, these Terms and Conditions may be updated to address any errors or to clarify information and re-published online at <https://www.stpaulsmtl.wa.edu.au> or otherwise as required by the requirements of the Permit or the Department of Racing, Gaming and Liquor WA.

**Excluded purchasers:** Tickets must not be purchased by the Lottery Permit Holder. Excluded purchasers will not be entitled to collect the prize.
